To ensure this;

- ❖ We do not allow child labour in our own institutions and expect the same sensitivity from all our business partners
- ❖ Within the business, we provide environments and opportunities that contribute to the development of children, where they can freely express their thoughts, wishes, and feelings, and feel free and comfortable
- ❖ We provide training to our employees on the prevention and recognition of child abuse.
- ❖ We ensure that children are under the supervision of an adult during the activities they participate in.
- ❖ We organise training sessions and support relevant projects to raise awareness about the protection of children's rights.
- ❖ When we witness suspicious actions involving children, we first inform the hotel management and seek assistance from official institutions in cases deemed necessary.
